2. List 2 laws of physics demonstrated by the Physics Circus.  
(See the Physics Circus by the bridge to the left of the planetarium building.)
3. What is the pattern used to grind a telescope mirror (similar to what letter)?  
(See the telescope mirror grinding demo by the Museum iron gates.)
4. Name 3 ways you can decrease light pollution in and around your home.  
(See the light pollution booth by the Museum iron gates.)
5. Observe the sun at three different wavelengths and list those wavelengths.  
Hint: “observe” doesn’t just refer to using your eyes! (Weather permitting.) Warning:  
Never look at the sun directly without proper eye protection.  
(See the solar telescopes by the museum iron gates.)
